



ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR SCHOLARSHIPS

The parent, legal guardian or the applicant themselves must receive their electrical power from Wyrulec Company to be eligible.

Special cases of the above requirement are:

Parent's residence is on our service line as a landlord/rental agreement.

Applicant lives with a grandparent or other family member on our service line.

Eligibility requirements vary on each scholarship listed below:

TRI-STATE GENERATION & TRANSMISSION SCHOLARSHIPS: Applicant must be a senior in high school or any eligible college student. **Two (2) scholarships will be awarded in the amount of \$1,000.**

WYRULEC COMPANY TRADE SCHOLARSHIPS: Recipients chosen for these scholarships must be attending an accredited trade or vocational school. Awarded in the amount of \$1,000. Applicant must be a senior in high school or any eligible college student. **Four (4) scholarships to be awarded.**

WYRULEC COMPANY SCHOLASTIC SCHOLARSHIPS: Awarded in the amount of \$1,000. Applicant must be a senior in high school or any eligible college student. **Four (4) scholarships to be awarded.**

Applications must be completed in full. Applications will not be considered unless all requested requirements are met.

Preference is given to applicants that have not been awarded a scholarship from Wyrulec Company, or Tri-State G&T in the past.

A selection committee outside of Wyrulec Company chooses the recipients.
