Scholastic Scholarship Application Requirements

APPLICATION DEADLINE: FEBRUARY 1, 2022

Applications must be RECEIVED in the office on the due date, not postmarked.

1. Complete this application (attach additional sheets as necessary). Your name and address should be on all attachments.
2. Enclose your most recent academic transcript whether it be from a high school, college, university, or trade school.
*CURRENT COLLEGE FRESHMAN – Committee requires more than one semester or quarter of grades. If this applies to you, submit your high school transcript.
3. Enclose a copy of your college entrance examination (ACT and/or SAT) scores.
4. Enclose a statement written by you outlining your career goals and employment history.
5. Enclose at least one letter of reference from a teacher, counselor, employer, or co-op system manager.
6. Document high school/college honors, community and school activities, and list any other scholarships you have been awarded for this coming year.
7. Enclose a picture of yourself. If selected for a scholarship, a digital photo file will be needed along with a note acknowledging the source of the photo. The scholarship recipients' photos will be published in the Wyrulec newsletter featured in the WREN magazine.
8. Answer the following essay question: *A bachelor's degree from an accredited college can mean that by the time a person retires, he or she has earned at least \$800,000 more than someone without a college degree (\$20,000 per year for 40 years.) What would you do if you had the entire amount, \$800,000, today? Explain.*
